Menu Options

When choosing the add on of a one or two course meal, one dish is selected from below for the whole group.

Mains:

- Steak & ale pie, chips, garden peas and gravy (gfa)
- Beef lasagne, garlic bread, mixed salad (gfa)
- Vegetable lasagne, garlic bread, mixed salad (gfa)(v)
- Chicken cassoulet, creamy mashed potato, roasted vegetables (gf)
- Mildly spiced chicken curry, basmati rice and naan bread (gfa)
- Fish pie topped with creamy mashed potato, garden peas (gf)
- Crispy jacket potatoes with mixed salad, coleslaw and a selection of fillings: barbecue pulled pork, coronation chicken, tuna mayonnaise, grated cheese, baked beans (gf) (vga)
- Ploughman's lunch including crusty bread, sliced ham, pork pie, cheese, scotch egg, chutney, grapes and celery (gfa)

Desserts:

- House cheesecake, fruit coulis and pouring cream

When arriving at our club

Upon arrival, please visit the pro shop and let our team know you have arrived. Here, you can collect your scorecards and find all the information you need, including local rules and course details.

Dress Code

Course:

- Golfing attire, polo/collared shirts, tailored shorts or trousers. No jeans, no sport shorts, no tracksuit bottoms, and no football shirts
- Golf shoes must be worn on the course
- Socks must be worn with shorts

Clubhouse:

- Smart casual
- No vests
- Hats must be removed in the clubhouse
- Golf shoes NOT to be worn in the main clubhouse area
- Please remove all wet clothing and items from your person before entering the clubhouse

Each player must have their own set of golf clubs

Please ensure all members of your group are aware of the golfing standard dress code both on the course and in the clubhouse to save any potential embarrassment on the day.



Confirming Details

Terms of Booking

To help us provide the best possible experience for your society, please ensure that any changes to your booking are communicated to us as soon as possible. Final numbers must be confirmed 14 days prior to the event.

Meals

A menu selection list should be circulated and completed prior to your event. Please ensure that we are made aware of any dietary requirements or allergies in advance of your event so that we can accommodate your guests wherever possible. Final meal choices must be provided at least 14 days before the event, and unfortunately, changes cannot be made after this point.

Cancellation Policy

If cancelling your visit for any reason, the deposit of £100 will be used as a cancellation fee. If cancelling 14 to 7 days prior to the event you will be refunded 50% of the total cost. If cancelling less than 7 days prior to the event full payment will be lost.

Weather

Unless the course is closed, no price reductions will be made for inclement weather conditions. If the course closes for your visit we will look to find a suitable date for a return later in the year. If no suitable date is found, then the green fee element of your package will be refunded to your group.



Terms & Conditions of Play

Tee Times

Visiting societies are welcome throughout the year and tee times are subject to availability. Please see our booking form for pricing.

Format

3 or 4 balls only. Texas Scramble competitions are not permitted unless agreed with the Club.

Handicaps

A bona-fide handicap is not required but all players must be competent golfers. You should also have good knowledge of the etiquette of the game of golf.

Pace of play

Whether members, guests or visitors of the Club, we are keen to make sure everyone enjoys their day. Therefore, please be advised that 4-ball games are expected to complete the course in 4 hours and 10 minutes.



Payment

Please note that all prices quoted are inclusive of VAT. Should your numbers drop below 13 you will be charged the interim green fee rate of the day.

Terms & Conditions

To secure your booking a £100 deposit is payable by cash, debit card or credit card (in person via a Chip & PIN card or over the phone on 01636 626282, or by bank transfer. The final balance is due at least 14 days prior to your visit, reservations will not be confirmed without payment of the deposit.

Fire:

In an event of a fire, the fire assembly point is:

- The far end of the large car park

Located close to the main entrance gate.

Lightning:

In the event of lightning, play MUST be discontinued

If it is decided that it is unsafe to continue because of lightning, the pro shop will sound a siren to call ALL GOLFERS off the course and into the clubhouse. A second siren will sound when its safe to play once again.
